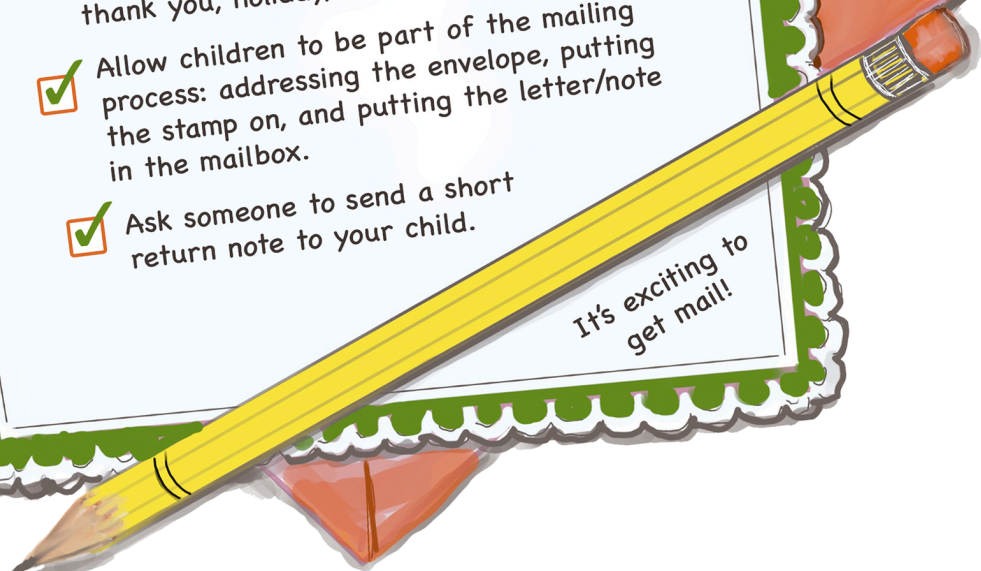

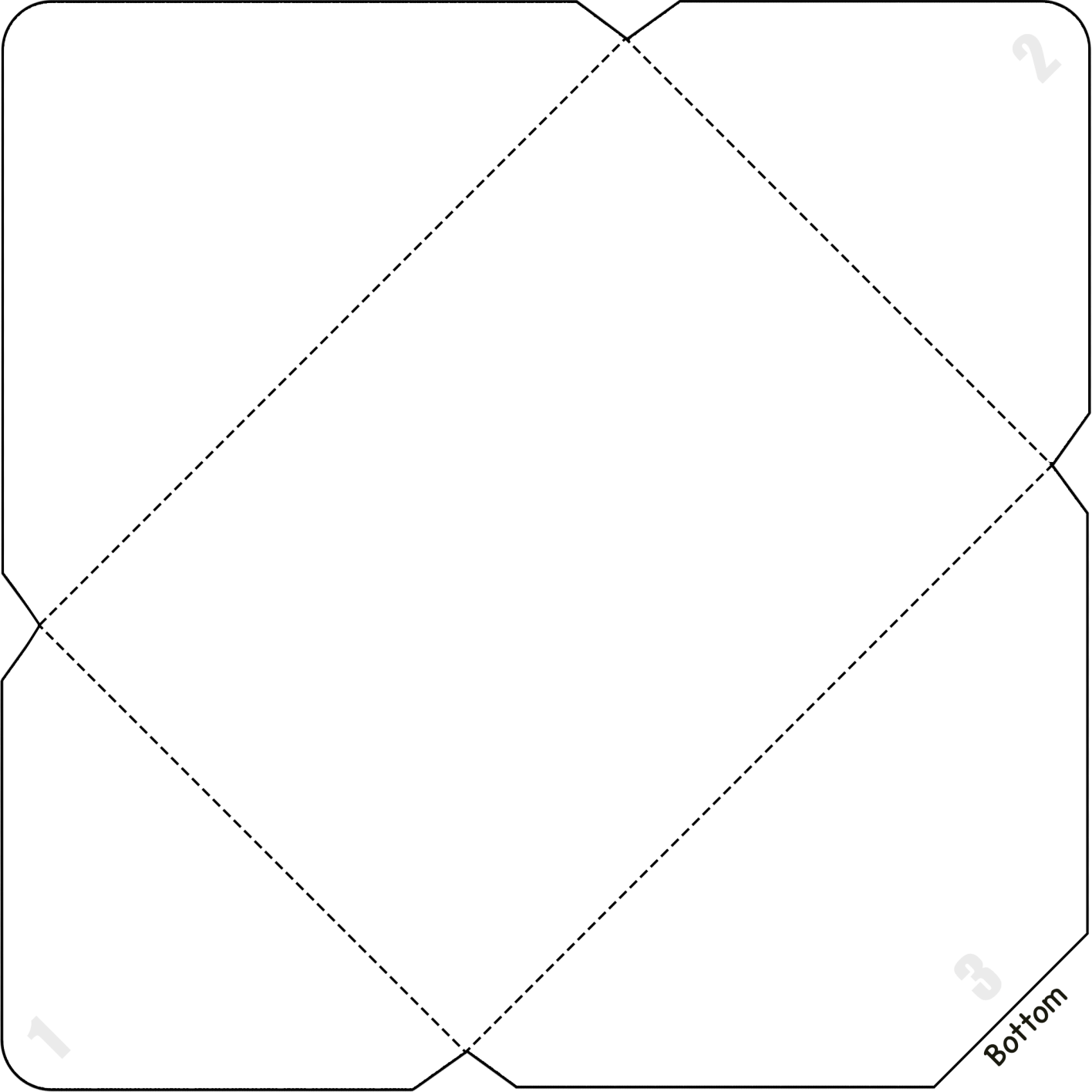
M. Mouse's tips for encouraging kids to write

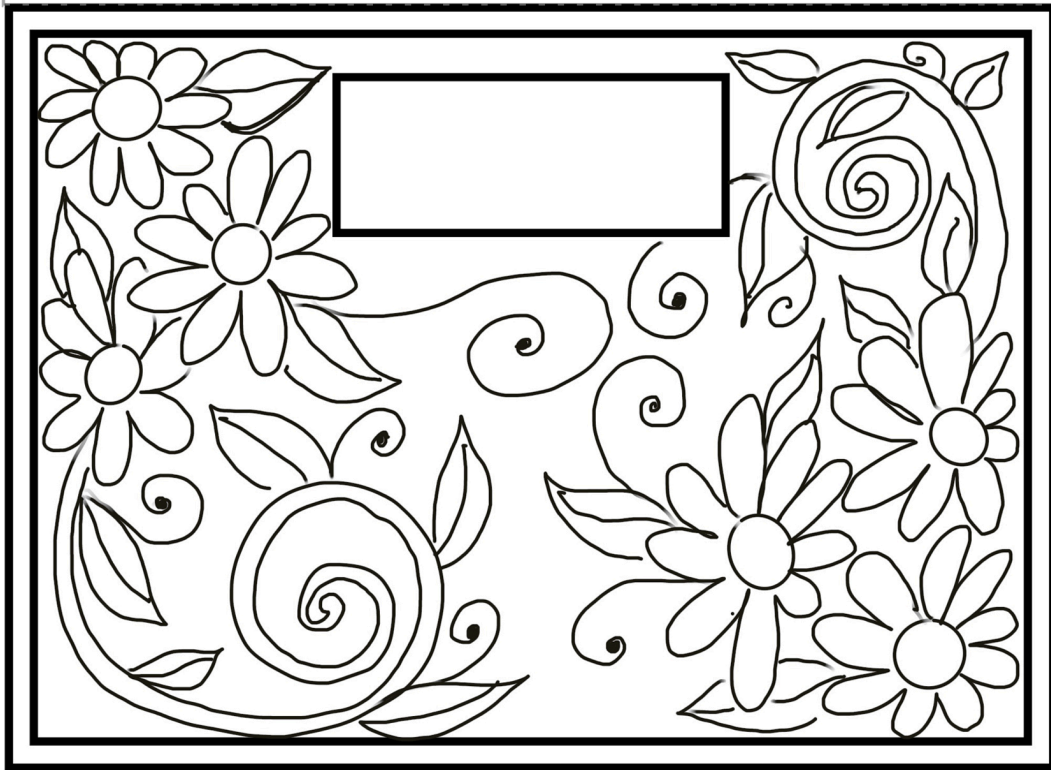
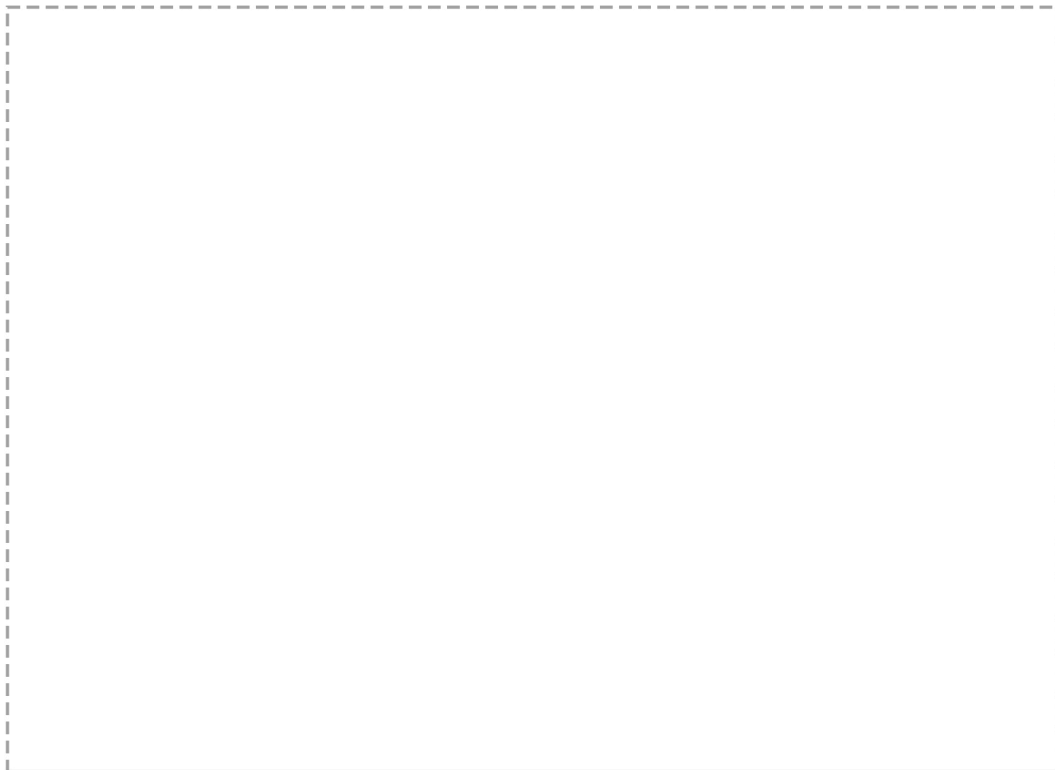
- ✓ Help your child make a "letter supplies" box with note cards, paper, crayons, envelopes, stickers, stamps, etc.
- ✓ Encourage them to write notes or send a picture at appropriate times, for example, thank you, holiday, hello or get well cards.
- ✓ Allow children to be part of the mailing process: addressing the envelope, putting the stamp on, and putting the letter/note in the mailbox.
- ✓ Ask someone to send a short return note to your child.

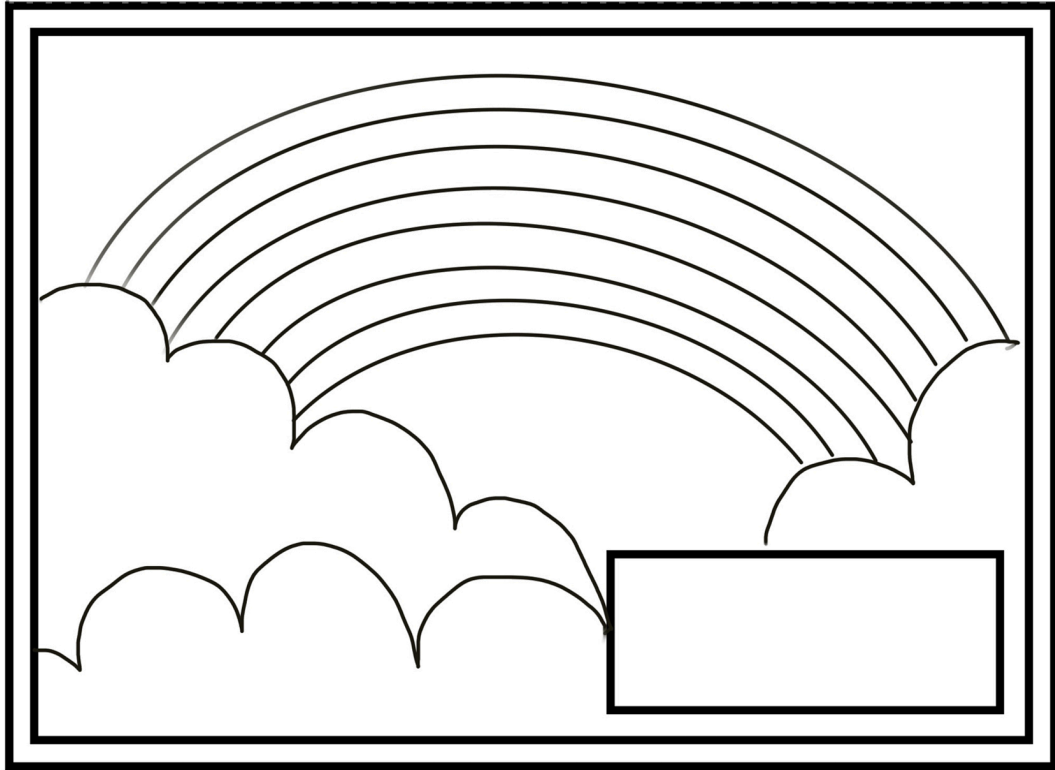
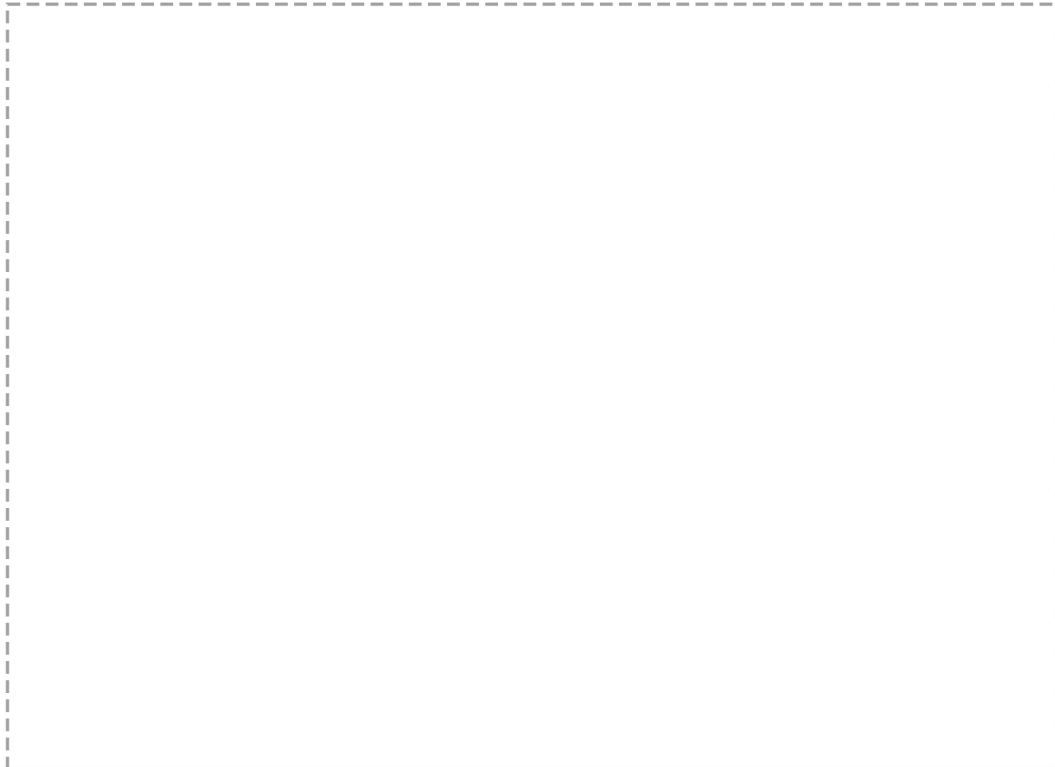

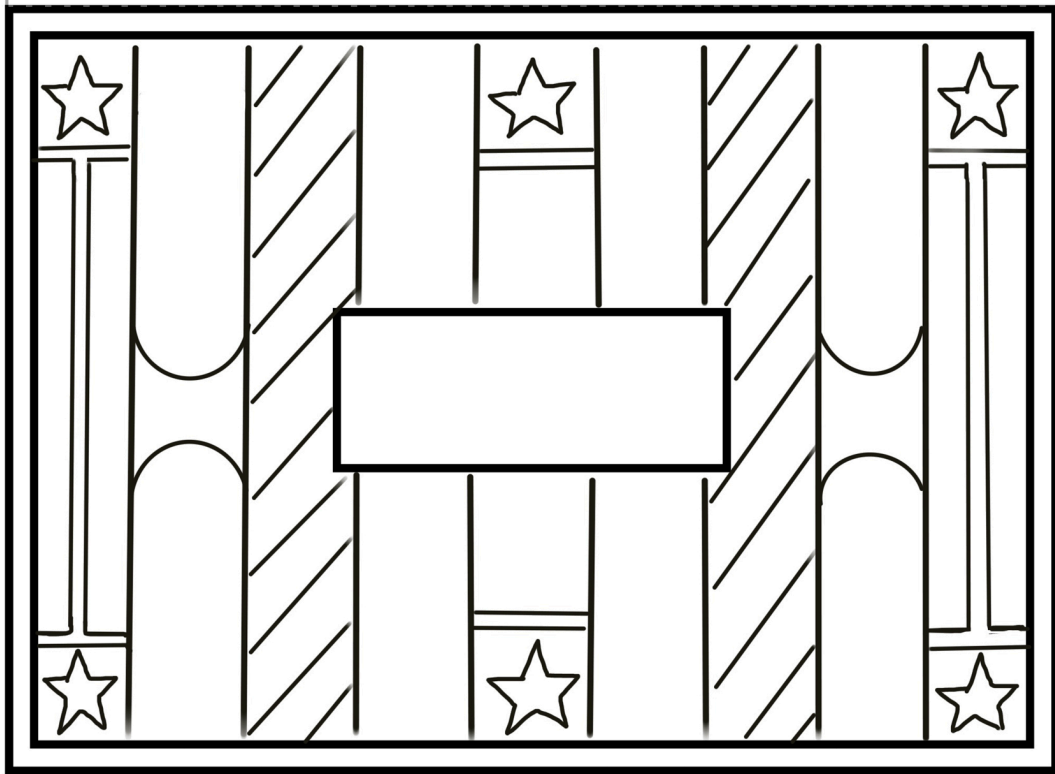
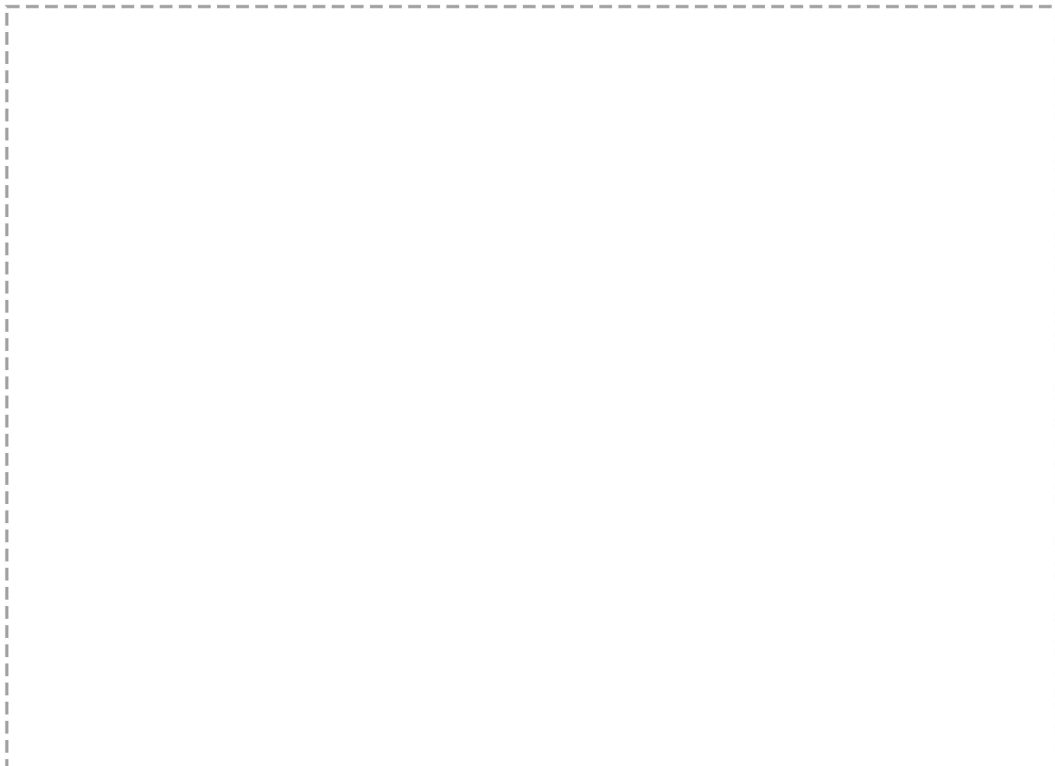


Envelope Template - Fold template in numbered order and tape or glue together.
